Legal English

The course will cover:

- Introduction to the Common Law – sources
- Court structure
- The legal profession in England and Wales
- Contract Law – basic principles; offer, acceptance, remedies for breach.
- Standard form commercial contracts; standard terms in supply of goods contracts.
- Introduction to the law of Tort – principles of civil liability
- Company law - introduction to basic principles and business entities
- Insolvency and winding up of companies
- Employment law – typical contracts; discrimination
- Intellectual property law – copyright and patent
- Criminal law – basic vocabulary, categories of criminal offence
- Alternative dispute resolution
- Client care and procedures; client correspondence
- Key grammar skills
- Improved pronunciation
- Key professional skills including: negotiations, presentations, meetings, telephoning and email writing.

There will also be plenty of opportunity for role play and team building, as well as tense, grammar and language practice. The teacher will set homework regularly and in addition there will be teacher feedback throughout the course and a progress meeting with your teacher.

Lunch Club

On two days a week you can enjoy a light lunch in small groups with Frances King staff or other guest English speakers.

Electives

English for Work and Business

Focus on English for international business communication. Classes include language for marketing, management, financial services and human resources as well as spoken English skills for meetings, negotiations and presentations.
